IT -Create comic strip (Strip Designer app) Books (Creative Book Builder app). Rewrite stories/ character descriptions. Morfo app – as character from story. Design book covers

Digital Literacy - Powerful passwords/storing safely. Communicating online safely and responsibly

Turtle on screen software e.g. Textease.

pictures e.g. a house

IT – Effective searching when making leaflet/museum guide/catalogue of artefacts/newspaper article e.g. Hadrian's Wall/a guide to Roman army for beginners. Interview a Legionnaire. Compose Roman music. Photograph artefacts. Roman adventure programs. Presentation on an aspect of history topic
